Historic Site Etiquette

1

Do not touch the objects or displays

Oils from your hands can damage the art and historic items.

2

Keep 12 inches from the art

Art can easily be bumped by accident. Help us care for the collection by keeping a safe distance.

3

No food or drinks in the galleries & historic rooms

Outdoor picnicking encouraged; Carry In-Carry Out!

4

No pets allowed *Except while leashed & attended in the picnic area only. Waste must be picked up & carried out. If leaving animal in the car make sure there is proper ventilation or the police will be contacted by caring visitors and staff.*

5

Service animals welcome *throughout the property, please the notify the Admissions Desk. Note: therapy animals are not protected under ADA or MA state regulations and thus only allowed in picnic area as described above.*

No backpacks

If unable to leave in your vehicle, please wear it on your front to avoid bumping the artwork.

Child carriers *Children may be worn in front carriers. In an effort to protect the art collection, backback carriers are not permitted in historic rooms or galleries.*

Compact strollers permitted

Umbrella strollers permitted in galleries & historic rooms, please leave larger strollers outside. We have one stroller available for use (first come, first served).
